We offer a \$50 discount on the annual meeting. It is important to clarify that we only do annual services.

- Remove all external covers to expose all inner workings.
- Complete Cleaning with compressed air and remove all shredded or caughtup thread.
- Lubricate the machine to the manufacturer's guidelines.
- Adjust hook and needle clearances.
- Position of needle in needle plate (left to right and front to back).
- Balance upper and lower thread tensions.
- Take up shaft play and gear lash (translation makes loose parts tight again).
- Adjust motor and timing belt tension.
- Time feed motion & Feed dog height adjustment.
- Balance forward and reverse feeding.
- Align the presser foot and height.
- Hook to needle clearance & Hook timing.
- Adjust the bobbin winder and Bobbin winder auto stop.
- Fine-Tune foot control speed calibration.
- Sew-Off to ensure all functions are operating to factory specifications.



Shelley Yarrington, Stacey Ryerson, Jackie, Michelle, Nancy and I will work the show.


In October we delivered 20 quilts and 20 pillowcases to Foster Care.

Here are the rules, please read carefully as there are a couple changes from previous swaps

 Make a small quilt using these three fabric colors: BLACK / WHITE / AND YOUR FAVORITE COLOR

2. Your small quilt can be any shape, as long as the outer dimensions are no smaller than 72" and no bigger than 96". For example, an 18x16-square small quilt will equal 72", a 24x24-square quilt will equal 69", and an 18x24' obtoing quilt will equal 64". Starting in 2026, we will measure the quilt so writy they meet the small quilt size requirements. Please measure your quilt before submitting it; I don't want to distinuality it.

 Small Cults must be completed before the event, as they will be displayed all day Friday through the General Meeting Saturday. If you cannot attend the meeting, please give the quits to Jeannette Smith during QADM or to me.


