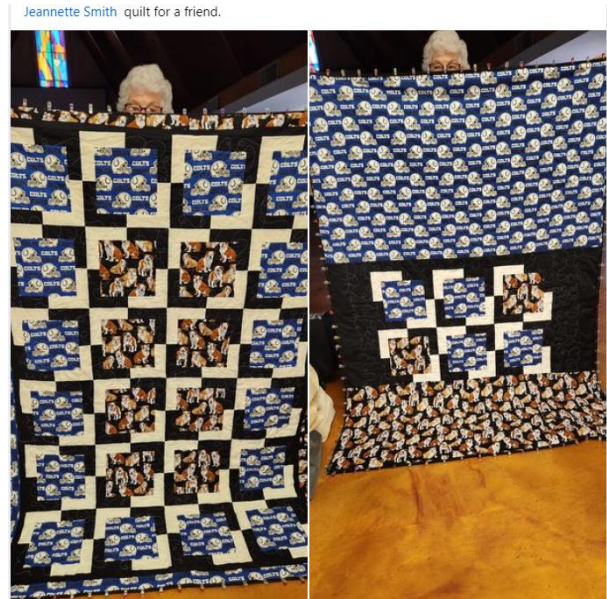

### Long Arm Quilting Fundraiser

Open to Guild members in good standing only. Fees to be paid directly to the treasurer.

At this time, there are only 2 quilting spots available per month so please email [pat.shipp@att.net](mailto:pat.shipp@att.net) to schedule. \$20 deposit is required when dropping off your quilt

Largest size we can accept is 85" x 100"

#### AVAILABLE SERVICES:

Quilting - \$.01 per square inch (\$20 minimum fee no matter how small your quilt is.)

Your choice of meander or available pantograph designs.

Thread fee - If you are supplying your own top thread please purchase Coats & Clark quilting thread available at JoAnns, it comes in both solid and variegated colors.

(See photo on the last page.)

To avoid bobbin tension issues, we need to use our thread on the back.

\$4 Top & Back (Solid color choices)

\$2 Back only (Your thread to be used on the top)

Batting - You may use your own batting or purchase 80/20 batting from us.

Please - no fusible batting! If you use your own batting, the batting must be 2 bigger on all sides then the quilt top. This price is for the entire quilt, not by the yard.

SMALL \$6

MEDIUM \$9

LARGE \$12

Backing must be 4 wider than the quilt top and 6 longer. Piece quilt backing \$5 (for quilts wider than the width of fabric) If piecing your own backing, please square it up, iron, and press the seam open.

Attach Binding - Includes trimming quilt and stitching your prepared binding to the front.

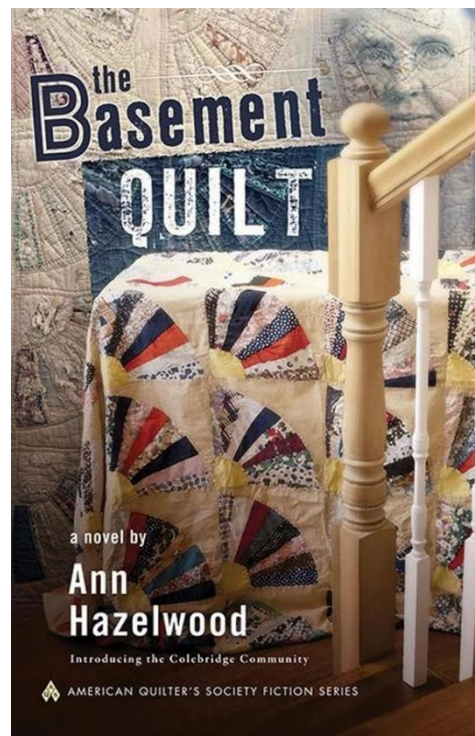

Cost \$25 which includes one of her one patch acrylic templates.

We will be collecting the class fees at our meetings for members; for non-members we will be collecting the day of the event.

**Non-members, please RSVP so we can make sure we have enough tables set up for you.**

Pat Yamin will be holding her Scrappy Quilts Your Way class following our very very short June meeting 9:30 to 10:00am,

If your closets are bulging with those bins of scraps waiting to someday be used in a project, this new workshop with Pat Yamin offers exactly what you need! Fabrics that look good on the bolt but not so good when you get them home are stored and forgotten. Now Pat's expertise will help you turn those fabrics into a special quilt!

Scraps of light, medium, and dark fabric and/or strips are required. When you get

to class, you'll find a table set up where students can place the scraps they want to exchange, the rule being take one, leave one. Fabrics you dislike (most likely will never use) might turn out to be your classmate's treasure. And Pat will toss in some of her scraps too.

Next, students will select a template from Pat's assortment of one-patch templates and get started rotary cutting. Everyone will receive an individual bag to drop the cut pieces into. Next, students will shake up and mix the chosen scraps and start sewing on their machine.

**Important Note:** This is a stress-free casual class offering the opportunity to create an impromptu design and exchange fabric scraps with other quilters. It is not geared to quilters who prefer formality. Join us for a fun day!

**All Levels – Students to Provide the following items:**

- o Required Kit: \$25. for class which includes Acrylic Template with seam allowances
- o Sewing Machine, with cord and user manual
- o ¼" foot for sewing machine
- o Neutral color thread
- o 25 mm Rotary Cutter (new blade)

  - Small scissors
  - Seam Ripper
  - o Lots of scraps to exchange 5" and bigger (bring one, pick one)
  - o Lunch and drinks
  - Sewing Machine required
